That journey began at Holmes Bible College, where we studied missions and theology before serving in Kenya's largest slum, rescuing children from trafficking, discipling new believers, and learning firsthand that comfort has no place in the call to reach the lost. God later led us to move to South Africa, shaping our hearts with a simple but bold mission: to make unreached people groups a thing of the past.

We've learned that meeting physical needs is vital, but without the Gospel, the mission is incomplete. Every culture has unique challenges and barriers to faith, so we focus on people, not just projects, and we believe "unreachable" does not exist. As a bush pilot in training, I am preparing to fly into places roads can't reach, carrying the Gospel to the most remote and forgotten. Whether by bush plane, Land Cruiser, hiking boots, or dugout canoe, if it takes bringing clean water, teaching new farming methods, or kicking a soccer ball, we will go. Whatever it takes. Whoever needs to hear.

Our calling also now includes raising up and equipping the next generation of missionaries through Church of God World Missions. We believe it's our responsibility not only to go, but to train. We are at work mobilizing laborers who will take the light of Jesus into the darkest places on earth. Through internships, mission teams, storytelling, and partnerships, we work to keep the local church connected
