I'M A LITTLE HUNGRY

BRING OUT THE CONTAINER OF FOOD, AND PLACE IT ON THE TABLE.

HAVE THE NAPKINS, PAPER PLATES AND SILVERWARE ALREADY ON THE TABLE

I know we don't always have food in the Children's Service, but I was a little hungry today and thought I would bring a quick snack to eat half-way through service. Offering time seems like the perfect half-way point! I have enough here to share with two friends. So is there anyone else who may be hungry enough to eat a small snack?

CALL UP TWO CHILDREN AND PLACE ONE IN FRONT OF THE REAL SET OF DISHES AND THE OTHER IN FRONT OF THE DISPOSABLE SET.

MAKE SURE TO LET THEM KNOW THAT THIS ISN'T A GAME. YOU JUST WANTED TO SHARE SOME FOOD WITH THEM.



LET'S SNACK!

I only had two disposable table wares, so I brought a set of my dishes from home. It really doesn't matter which set you are eating from since it is the same food we are all eating.

GIVE EACH CHILD THE SAME PORTION AS YOU GIVE YOURSELF. THIS MUST BE A SMALL AMOUNT SO THAT IT DOES NOT TAKE LONG TO EAT.

I'm so glad I remembered to bring the dish set from home so that I could share this snack with you both. Again, I'm sorry that I didn't have enough for the whole class, but it really was a small amount.

See... we are already done eating!

SHOW CLASS YOUR EMPTY PAPER PLATE





TIME TO CLEAN UP!

Alright! It's time to clean up! When I'm eating at home, I always make sure to clean up after myself and I think we should do the same thing here! So let's clean this mess up!

GATHER YOUR PAPER PLATE, FORK AND NAPKIN AND HEAD OVER TO THE TRASH CAN. MAKE SURE TO THROW IT AWAY WITH A DRAMATIC GESTURE. THEN MOTION TO THE KIDS WHO ARE EATING...

You both go ahead and clean your places up as well.

LOOK AT BOTH OF THE STUDENTS AND POINT TO THE TRASH CAN.




TOSSING THE DISHES




HOPEFULLY THE CHILD WITH THE REAL PLATE WILL LOOK QUIZZICALLY AT YOU WHEN THEY ARE ASKED TO THROW THEIR REAL DISHES AWAY.

THE GOAL IS TO GET THE CHILD OR SOMEONE IN THE CLASS TO REBUTT OR QUESTION YOU WHEN GIVEN THE DIRECTION TO THROW THE VALUABLE ITEMS AWAY.



YOU CAN BE DRAMATIC ABOUT THIS PART AND BRING SOME HUMOR INTO THE LESSON BY ACTING LIKE IT IS NOT A PROBLEM TO TOSS THE REAL DISHES INTO THE TRASH.



WHEN YOU THE CHILD HAVE COME TO AN IMPASS AND THEY DO NOT WANT TO TOSS THE PLATE OR SOMEONE IN THE CLASS SPEAKS UP AND DOES NOT WANT IT TO BE THROWN AWAY - YOU ARE READY TO MOVE ON TO THE DISCOVERY POINT OF THE OFFERING LESSON. NOTE: THERE IS USUALY A CHILD WHO ENCOURAGES THE TOSSING OF THE REAL PLATES.

Why did you not want to throw the plate away?

ANSWERS: IT'S REAL (GLASS/CHINA),
IT'S WORTH MORE.

Why did you not want to throw the fork away?

ANSWERS: IT'S METAL, IT'S
SILVER, IT'S VALUABLE.

Why did you not want to throw the napkin away?

ANSWERS: IT'S MATERIAL, IT'S
PRETTY, IT'S WASHABLE.
