HELLO AGAIN!

A few weeks ago we talked about the different languages in the world. Does anyone remember how many different kinds there are?

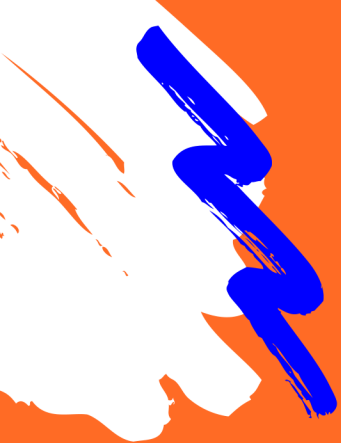
ANSWER: OVER 7,000
ALLOW CHILDREN TO
RESPOND





Have you ever met someone who you really wanted to talk to but they didn't speak your language? Showing kindness is universal, but having a conversation requires actual conversation. If you wanted to talk with them, what would you do?

GET A TRANSLATOR... THERE ARE A FEW KINDS:
A PERSON OR A PROGRAM



COMMUNICATING REQUIRES HELP

If you want to speak with someone who doesn't understand your language, you are going to need help! You mentioned finding a friend who knows their language or using something like Google translator. Either way, you have to find help to communicate with them.

PULL UP TWO CHILDREN TO HELP YOU

If the first child speaks one language and the second child speaks another one and neither one of them have learned the other's language yet, they must get someone who is bi-lingual to speak for both of them.

PULL A THIRD CHILD TO HELP YOU





CLEAR UNDERSTANDING

When the bi-lingual person is present, there is a clear understanding of the conversation and both people can be involved instead of just standing there and looking at each other. Which can be very uncomfortable!

GIVE THE FIRST CHILD A PIECE OF PAPER THAT READS "JESUS LOVES YOU"

If the first child has a very important message that they want to share with their new friend, they **MUST** have the interpreter translate the message for them so that the true meaning is understood.

GIVE THE MIDDLE CHILD A PIECE OF PAPER THAT HAS "MAHAL KA NI HESUS" (FILIPINO)

Now the interpreter has the same message but in two different languages. They know what the original message said and they can translate those exact words for the new friends.

HAVE THE INTERPRETER GIVE THE FILIPINO MESSAGE TO THE SECOND CHILD




MISSIONARIES ARE INTERPRETERS



Now lets look at our three friends up here through the eyes of World Missions. Everyone hold up three fingers on both of your hands and gently put those fingers on your eyes and pray, "Lord, help me to see through the eyes of World Missions."

LEAD THE CHILDREN IN THIS ACTIVITY BY PLACING YOUR FINGERS OVER YOUR EYES AND PRAYING. WHEN YOU HAVE SAID THE SIMPLE PRAYER, PLACE THE "MISSIONARY" SIGN ON THE INTERPRETERS

Missionaries are not just interpreters that you call in for a single conversation. They are willing to go be full-time message givers! You can trust the missionary to carry the truth of the gospel message.



TAKE THE FILIPINO MESSAGE FROM THE MISSIONARY AND PLACE IT IN THE FLOOR IN FRONT OF THEM. THEN HAND THE FIRST CHILD \$1 AND SEND THEM BACK TO THEIR SEAT.

You and I may not be able to go in person to another country and stay long enough to make deep friendships and share the Good News week in and week out. We can help our friend, the missionary, do that! We can help them stay long enough to make good friends and share the Gospel to others who speak another language!

PULL OUT THE OFFERING CONTAINER AND ASK THE CHILD WITH THE \$1 TO COME FORWARD AND PLACE IT IN THE CONTAINER.

You see when we give to the 365 Kids Club, we are actually giving money to our missionary friends and do you know what they are doing with it?

PULL THE \$1 FROM THE OFFERING CONTAINER AND PLACE IT IN THE HAND OF THE MISSIONARY.

When the missionary receives the offering they are able to buy supplies to give to the children in their new country and tell them about Jesus!

OFFERING = GOSPEL

HAVE THE MISSIONARY PLACE THE \$1
ON THE FLOOR AND PICK UP THE SIGN.

The missionary is able to use the offering you give
to the 365 Kids Club and share the good news with
children in the different language they are living in.

HAVE THE MISSIONARY GIVE THE
"MAHAL KA NI HESUS" SIGN TO THE
SECOND CHILD.

Once the child hears the good news that Jesus loves them in
their own language they can understand the truth of God's Word
and how much He loves them that He would send His only Son
to die for them and to give them new life! That is amazing news
and any heart who hears it and receives it is a happy heart!

ASK THE SECOND CHILD TO SMILE AND
FIST BUMP THE MISSIONARY WHO
GAVE THEM THE GIVE THE "MAHAL KA
NI HESUS" SIGN
